Each year since 1990, the International Leadership Institute has taken a 2-3-day retreat to plan the upcoming year's activities. During this retreat we consider our past accomplishments while seeking a vision for the upcoming year.

Over the past seventeen years, these meetings have taken place in such beautiful and inspirational settings as Marienbad, Czechoslovakia; Murren, Switzerland; Jekyll Island, Georgia; Maggie Valley, North Carolina; Cloudland Canyon, Georgia, and Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida. For the 2008 retreat we chose Crooked River State Park in St. Mary's, Georgia, as a quiet and peaceful place to plan for not just 2008, but for the next five years.

ILI's New Mission

Friends and supporters of the Institute know that we have always focused on helping people. Sara and I are both educators at heart, and are most effective when we teach. Our teaching specialties include leadership and career development, as well as con-

versational English. Each ILI mission has included educational programs; the new mission follows the tradition.

Changes coming in 2010

Sara and I have become increasingly committed to us-

We plan to move the Institute's headquarters to Prague in June 2010, to run a new, 2-year program, "Cesta Tam" ("there is a way" in Czech). The purpose of Cesta Tam is to provide conversational English lessons to young, career-minded Czechs, to befriend them and to introduce them to Christ in the process.

We will need to use all of our entrepreneurial and leadership skills and talents to develop a well-run ministry, so we can discover how to meet the needs of Czechs living in a sophisticated, skeptical culture. We must balance the requirements of God for His people with the changing desires and difficulties of the people we want to reach.

Values and Principles

Our core values and principles include the following:

- i. resistance to catering to society’s insatiable demand for entertainment;
- ii. presenting a God-centered rather than a me-centered teaching;
- iii. realizing that people are essentially sinners in need of salvation, rather than going along with the popular belief that all people are essentially good;
- iv. preaching the full Gospel of Christ, including the hard-to-accept parts, rather than preaching a “Christianity lite” message of the Gospel mixed with pop psychology.
- v. clearly providing an alternative to secular culture rather than trying to mesh with its values and principles.

We need to capture the attention of those



who will come our way to investigate our ministry through our English lessons, not turn them away by making them feel inadequate. Our model is Jesus, Who spoke directly to people’s needs.

A New Educational Program

Our goal is to invite our English students to our advanced English sessions, and then to our Alpha sessions, mentoring program and church-related activities such as prayer groups and Bible studies.

Our calling is to teach people how to be successful in following Jesus by applying His teachings to everyday life. We will provide a customized spiritual-growth plan for anyone willing to walk with Christ, to provide mentoring of new disciples, who will then be equipped and find new disciples.

Our New Mission

We at ILI believe our new mission is to help the people whom God will send our way in the Czech Republic to discover (through a growing relationship with Jesus Christ, our redeemer and savior) the true potential that God has planted within them.

We will use a refined “seeker” ministry model, believing that one of the best ways to reach the irreligious is to lower the threshold between the church and the secular world (without compromising the essential evangelical message of the Good News of Jesus Christ). By offering practical help in English and by becoming friends before we evangelize, we hope to “lower the threshold” to becoming a follower of Jesus Christ.
